# Rigory

In Science, we didn't just read about "doing technology," we worked in our science teams to "do technology." We solved an open-ended problem – the fire alarm is broken but you have to alert your class to evacuate the building because of a fire. We identified a problem, got ideas to solve the problem, designed a solution, carried out the solution, evaluated the solution, and shared the results with our class. Ask your child about his/her team's solution.

<u>Math</u>: As we finish Unit 4, we're working on strategies to help us add 2-digit numbers. When we move on to Unit 5 next week, we will be working on line segments, parallel lines, polygons, and 3-dimensional shapes.

<u>Writing</u>: We are beginning to write stories of our own based on a familiar plot. This week we reread <u>Honk!</u> and we are wrote stories that follow the <u>Honk!</u> plot. Coming next...we'll read <u>The Secret Shortcut</u> and we'll use it to write stories about a time when we made preposterous excuses.

**Reading:** In reading, we continued our work on summaries. We read a book about a class visit to a firehouse. Our summaries included 2 important facts from each section.

<u>Science</u>: We are very excited by our work with Sound! We're using our senses to observe sound systems as they make sound. We're asking the questions - What do I see moving? What do I feel? What do I hear?
